

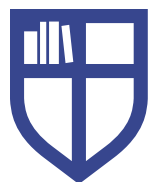

## Governing Board President's Message



Dear NAES Members  
and Friends:

The academic year 2005-06, for NAES, seems to have flown, yet parts of it seem to have taken place so very long ago. Very much like life in our schools

is it not? A year that began with Hurricane Katrina, and ended with the Rev. Peter Cheney's decision to make 2006-07 his last as Executive Director of the Association, was filled with what I can only call—to borrow Jon Glass' famous phrase—"life's rich pageant!"

Hurricane Katrina was a national tragedy. In our small part of the world, you in Episcopal schools rose generously to the human need. Episcopal schools raised tens of thousands of dollars for the relief efforts, offered prayers for the victims, provided refuge for displaced students and families, and entered into partnerships with affected schools that will continue as rebuilding efforts continue. It was at once heart breaking and heart warming to see the need and to see the effort made to meet so much of the need.

The response at our schools was also a powerful reminder to me of how those who serve in Episcopal schools recognize that tragedy, whether impacting many or just one, can be a powerful teaching moment. I was filled with admiration and gratitude to hear story after story about people in our schools modeling and teaching for those in their charge the way to serve, indeed to behave, when confronting some of the worst that this life can present, especially those directly hit by the storms themselves. How special indeed to watch heads, chaplains, teachers and staff recognize the moment and ask themselves "what now do I teach?"

NAES' Strategic Plan, adopted in 2001, continued to guide our work in 2005-06. Conferences were offered for chaplains, and for parish school leaders, steady progress was made in moving from a print to a web based delivery system for NAES publications, along with the steady work of Peter Cheney, and consultants Tom Clarke and Laura Walker as they advise, coach, guide and mentor those who serve as volunteer and professional leaders in our schools.

Considerable time was spent by staff and Governing Board members on a vision for the next Strategic Plan for NAES. The plan will be shared with the membership prior to Biennial this coming fall, but I can share that the goals of continuing to help schools understand and live out their Episcopal identity, and to promote and support exemplary leadership and governance remain primary.

Speaking of Biennial Conference 2006, I look forward to seeing and being with you—heads, trustees, rectors, chaplains, faculty and friends—at this wonderful and important gathering. Biennial is an occasion of joy, of learning, of renewed friendships and of recommitment to the special work we do.

We said goodbye to some wonderful friends who have served on the Governing Board. At our meeting in April we all had the opportunity to thank and offer our love and best wishes to the Rt. Rev. Sam Hulsey, Ms. Judy Robbins, and the Rev. Michael Robinson. They each served well and will be missed. In late July we received word that Governing Board member Ed Young had lost his long and courageous battle with cancer. We celebrate Ed's life and service, grieve for his family, and offer our prayers as we ask for yours.

As I write, the Governing Board is consulting, listening and gathering information; all of which will be most useful in helping prepare the search for our next Executive Director. I will report to the membership on our next steps after the September meeting of the Governing Board.

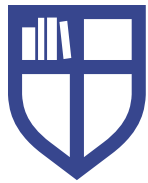

## Executive Director's Message

Dear NAES Members  
and Friends,

It is my privilege, on behalf of my colleagues on the staff and Governing Board of the Association, to summarize the initiatives and work of NAES during the 2005-2006 year. That said, no chronicle of the doings of an organization can adequately capture the heart and spirit of an organization's life.



The Association's job, so to speak, is to "serve those who serve Episcopal schools," particularly in the areas of *Episcopal Identity* and *Leadership and Governance*. After eight years in my role, I am most struck by the dedication, excellence and inspiring human qualities of all of you who make up the community of leaders and educators in NAES. More than anything else I want to express my gratitude to all of you for who you are and for the ways in which you lead and serve. Our collective work is ultimately about children and young people, and I am frankly proud to be in a ministry knowing and trusting that each of you has chosen to do all in your power to help our students to grow into their full stature as God's children. You probably cannot fully realize how significant your leadership is as a model to your students of service and stewardship—you embody the joy that is to be found in the incredible vocation of education, when all around our students there is so much that would cause fear or disillusionment as they face a very uncertain future in our society and wider world.

Thinking about this fear and disillusionment I am reminded of the heroic courage and bravery that Episcopal school leaders in

Louisiana and Mississippi demonstrated in the face of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Truly, the mission of Episcopal schools was a God-send in that time of need.

I am also grateful to all of you who rallied and are still rallying to support your fellow Episcopal schools and their families in their immediate and long-term need. The devastation was catastrophic and the road to recovery is long. Our connection with one another was never more visible and needed. My hat's off to you all.

### **Assisting Schools and Their Leaders**

Like you, I am blessed by the companionship in my work of incredible and dedicated human beings. I am especially grateful for the service of Tom Clarke and Laura Walker as Senior Consultants to NAES this past year. They have done great work with many of you in the field as consultants, coaches and friends; likewise, they have been of wonderful service to the staff and Governing Board of the Association as we completed *Strategic Plan 2006* which will build on our plan of 2001 and focus the work of the Association for the foreseeable future.

Nothing could be accomplished on your behalf were it not for the love and labor of NAES' office staff—Linda Glad who directs our office; David Schnabel who manages communications and conferences (and who celebrated his 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary with NAES in January!); Violet Valentin who is our administrative associate; and Caroline Icaza who worked with me on membership and advancement matters. This past summer we said farewell to Caroline who left after two years to further her education. In fact, we have decided not to fill Caroline's position, but to integrate that work into the other existing office positions.

NAES is also blessed with what I truly believe to be a phenomenal Governing Board. Its President, David Charlton, and his colleagues, gave so generously of their time and talents (and treasure) this past year, particularly in the major efforts to design and adopt the new strategic plan. The Association is in wonderful hands as the Board prepares this school year for the transition to the leadership of a new Executive Director upon my departure June 30, 2007.

Consultations and school visits continued to be two of the most important activities of NAES. Whether by telephone or on-site, staff and Governing Board members provide a ministry of presence and celebration, or important advice and assistance to schools, school exploration committees and regional and diocesan school organizations. Celebrations included graduations, ordinations and alumni gatherings. Consultation work included assistance with Episcopal identity and religious life; school leadership and governance; strategic planning; preparation for leadership transition; school exploration and expansion. The Association conducted visits to and/or consultations with institutions and organizations in these cities and areas.

### **New Print/PDF Resources**

2005-2006 saw the completion and publication of two important new resources for Episcopal school leaders.

*Principles of Good Practices for Furthering Episcopal Identity in Episcopal Schools* was published this year and documents the formal impact of Episcopal Identity on the missions, characters, and programs of Episcopal schools. It is intended to provide school leaders and school communities with guiding ideas on the roles and responsibilities of school leaders and personnel in upholding Episcopal Identity. *Index of Selected Network Articles: August 1998-June 2006* was compiled and released as a PDF in June 2006. This interactive resource has been designed to assist NAES members in locating important articles offering professional or personal development advice and resources originally published in *Network*, the Association's newsletter. The

*Index* includes four indices (Subject, Author, Title and Issue), PDF bookmarks, e-mail links for requesting hard copies of articles and web site hyperlinks to PDF copies. It is located on the *Network* page in the Member Resources section of the web site.

2005-2006 was the fifth and final year of *Strategic Plan 2001*. As such the Governing Board, assisted by the staff and consultants, undertook a review of the past five years' work, scanned the association, Church and education environment in which NAES finds itself today, and set about crafting *Strategic Plan 2006*. 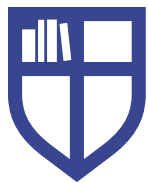

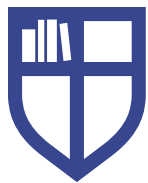

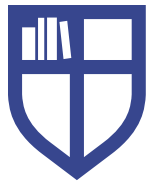

## Governing Board Treasurer’s Message

Dear Members and Friends of NAES,

The National Association of Episcopal Schools ended the 2005-2006 fiscal year in solid financial position. Increased membership revenue and income from conferences and investments enabled us to outperform our budgeted revenue goals, while keeping expenses well under budget.



Highlights of the 2005-2006 year are as follows.

### **Program & Investment Revenue**

This past year was a challenging one for the Association, as we dealt with the ongoing effects of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, and the financial impact on Episcopal schools in the affected areas. But even though actual membership was down slightly, NAES exceeded its budgeted membership revenue goal. Our member schools’ partnership with us and their continued support remain essential and are greatly appreciated.

NAES conducted two very successful conferences in Florida this year: the NAES/FCIS Leadership and Governance Institute held in Orlando in January, and the Chaplains Conference held in Tampa in February. Both conferences enjoyed higher attendance than originally anticipated.

Investment income increased dramatically as NAES has taken advantage of higher interest rates, and has a larger reserve fund to invest.

### **Expenses**

Program and administrative expenses were under budget by approximately \$92,000, thanks to the careful management of resources by NAES staff. Outreach grants were awarded to 18 member programs this year, reflecting a broad range of initiatives consonant with the mission of the Association.

In the final year of its five-year strategic plan, NAES made use of the remaining \$50,000 from the generous 2003 Good Samaritan Foundation grant (our temporarily restricted net assets) to help underwrite programmatic and operating expenses. Increased revenues and effective administrative cost-cutting lessened the impact on our unrestricted net assets, allowing us to use only \$17,404, compared to a budgeted draw-down of \$125,742. With your continued participation through sustained membership, attendance at NAES conferences, and contributions to the Annual Fund, the financial health of the Association will remain strong. NAES would not be able to provide these sorely-needed broad and effective ministries—both directly with you as well as on your behalf—without your support. We are grateful to you all.

5. Other Revenues is comprised of income from publication sales, consultation services, other conferences, reimbursed expenses, other services and grants in support of specific endeavors and events.

6. Strachan Fund revenue is the interest income derived from investments held in trust by The Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society of the Protestant Episcopal Church USA.

7. The National Association of Episcopal Schools occupies, without charge, an office suite in The Episcopal Church Center, 815 Second Avenue, New York, NY 10017. Its estimated fair rental value, utilities and in-kind services are reported as both revenue and administrative expenses.
