- “In Romans 12, Paul invites us to be a part of something greater than we already are. We need to be transformed – not by conforming to the world as we know it, but by living into the dream God intends for it. St. Paul realized that God is in the business of reconfiguring the nature of life, but knew that change within ourselves must come from a willingness to listen.*
- “So how do we, in this ever-busy world, leave room to listen to God? How do we, amid the sometimes frantic pace of school life, leave room to be transformed by God? Asking and answering these questions are both great challenges and great responsibilities.*
- “As a part of this Jesus Movement, we are called to a whole new way of looking at things. As Episcopal schools, we are positioned to lead that renewal and transformation in the minds of our young people. As long as we leave room to listen to God, we can be a force counter to that within our culture that constantly pulls our focus to the mundane.”*
