



Episcopal Urban School Alliance Grant Information & Application for 2020-2021

NAES gratefully acknowledges the Good Samaritan Foundation whose generous support of the Episcopal Urban School Alliance (EUSA) schools has made this grants program possible.

Eligibility

A school must be a member of both NAES and the EUSA for both the current year in which they apply and the year in which the grant is disbursed.

Purpose

Schools may apply for up to two grants:

- **Racial Justice:** A total of \$6,000 is available for grants to support initiatives to advance racial justice. Up to \$1,500 per grant will be awarded for activities, programs, and initiatives that advance and strengthen the school's capacity to dismantle racism and work towards racial justice and racial reconciliation.
- **Online Learning:** A total of \$6,000 is available for grants to increase the school's capacity to deliver effective remote and online learning. Up to \$1,500 per grant will be awarded to support programs and needs such as faculty professional development, subscriptions/purchases for the development or delivery of online learning, and ensuring equitable access to technology.

Application Deadline: August 15, 2020

Once completed, please send your application as a PDF to set@episcopalschools.org with the subject line "EUSA Grant Application." The document can be filled and signed digitally, or printed, however it must be returned via email.

Please make certain that your application is sent **on or before August 15, 2020**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

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Application Process and Requirements

Each application packet must include the following:

- **EUSA Grant Application Form** with applicable signatures.
- **Detailed budget** for the project for which the grant will be used.
- **Narrative statement** (four-page maximum) that includes the following information:
 - † A concise statement which explains the nature of your request or proposed project and its cost.
 - † A definition of the need which the request or project will address, your goals for the project and your hopes/expectations for outcomes. Tell us how you plan to accomplish your objectives.
 - † If your request is for partial funding, information about how you will fund the balance.

Selection Process and Notification

All grant applications will be reviewed by an EUSA Grants Committee appointed by the NAES Executive Director. No member of the Grants Committee may participate in the consideration of an application from his or her school. Selections will be made on the basis of the strength of the project as described and with attention to equitable distribution of grants among EUSA members.

Applicants will be notified on or before **September 15, 2020**.

Reporting and Documentation

Each grantee will submit a report to NAES that details the scope and impact of the project or purpose for which the grant was allocated, along with a statement of funds expended no later than May 1 of the following year.
