Ordained or lay chaplains beginning their first or second year as chaplain at an NAES member school are invited to apply. Applicants must be serving in at least a half-time capacity as a school chaplain.

## About the 2025–2026 Mentoring Program

Each new chaplain is matched with an experienced mentor. The program consists of:

- A one-hour online kick-off event held virtually on September 17, 2025, from 2pm to 3pm ET.
- An online professional development event for all mentors and mentees, held on October 8, 2025 from 11am to 1pm ET.
- Monthly mentor/mentee conversations.
- Semi-annual check-in with NAES staff members.
- Mentoring program celebration (virtual) on May 6, 2026 from 2pm to 3pm ET.
- Access resources about Episcopal schools, chaplaincy, and effective mentor/mentee relationships.
- In-person visits (optional).

There are no fees for the mentoring program. Schools are asked to release time for chaplains to participate in all program events.
