Outstanding candidates will be self-directed, possess exceptional rapport-building skills, have a generally upbeat and enthusiastic disposition, and enjoy working with other adults to encourage challenge, balance, and joy in the lives of adolescents.

Successful candidates for employment will have a demonstrated commitment to diversity, inclusion, and multicultural competence.

POSITION: Spanish Teacher

Duties and Responsibilities will include:

Teaching four sections of Spanish to students in grades 6-12:

- Planning, evaluating, and revising curricula, course content, and course materials and methods of instruction.
- Utilizing effective class management techniques to ensure effective learning.
- Maintaining regularly scheduled office hours in order to advise and assist students.
- Maintaining expertise in subject matter through professional development.
- Participating in departmental planning and curricular review.
- Serving as an advisor for Middle or Upper School Students.
- Leading evening and weekend campus activities and supervision.
- Coaching and/or teaching in our Afternoon Program.
- Additional Duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS, AND EXPERIENCE:

- Undergraduate and/or advanced degree in Spanish language or a related field.
- Enthusiasm and commitment to caring for adolescents.

- Commitment to St. Andrew's-Sewanee's mission and vision and comfort with the tenets of the Episcopal Church.
