Position Description:

Trinity is seeking applicants for a full-time physical education faculty position. A preferred candidate has middle and upper school experience in physical education, kinesiology, or a related field. This educator has the knowledge and skill to teach health, nutrition, and fitness. Qualified candidates must have the ability to develop meaningful relationships with highly motivated students from diverse backgrounds and excellent classroom management skills for whole group instruction. The instructor should plan to be an integral component of the students' lives, in and out of the classroom, and to collaborate with colleagues on grade-level teams, and serve as a member of the athletics and physical education department. This position will remain open until filled.

Trinity Prep has a one-to-one laptop program, and students use technology in a variety of ways in every discipline. They integrate electronic textbooks, utilizing Google Docs and Forms for assignments, and employ blended models to ignite teacher-student interaction. Using our learning management system Canvas and participating in the advisory program are required professional standards.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Foster a strong sense of belonging and community while promoting the School's mission and core values in the Middle and Upper School.
- Establish clear objectives for all lessons, units, and projects, and communicate those objectives to students.
- Develop assessments that evaluate students' understanding of physical education topics like health and development, nutrition and sports.
- Tracking student progress and development in physical education areas, such as motor skills, exercise, structured movement and other kinesthetic applications.
- Prepare instructional activities and lessons that incorporate movement- and exercise-based learning strategies.
- Adapt teaching methods and instructional materials to meet students' varying needs and interests.
- Engage students in movement-based activities that support learning and achievement in sports, exercise programs and other physical education areas
- Help students set and achieve physical education and health goals and guide students in developing their kinesthetic and motor skills.
- Communicate with staff and community about educational goals related to positive health outcomes and the physical development of students.
- Keep parents/guardians updated on educational activities and school events, student progress and achievement.
- Collaborate with other teachers and administrators in the development, evaluation, and revision of school programs.
- Nurture a group of assigned advisory students for the purpose of advising them on academics, social, and future-planning issues as well as acting as the liaison between the parents and school.
- Coach a fall, winter, or spring sport, in addition to teaching and advising.
- Attend professional meetings, educational conferences, and teacher training workshops in order to maintain and improve professional competence.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the supervising administrator.



Qualifications and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution or the international equivalent with a focus in physical education, health, or in a related field. Masters degree preferred.
- Minimum of 5 years prior experience in public and or independent schools, with a strong background in curriculum and instruction.
- Promotes an inclusive environment that values, encourages, supports differences, and articulates an authentic commitment to diversity in thought and perspective while holding others accountable for the same.
- Passionate about the chosen field of study.
- Capable of teaching all or more than one level of the subject, demonstrating a mastery of current pedagogy.
- Exceptionally capable in both written and oral communication.
- Excellent organizational and presentation skills.
- Proven success working collaboratively with other members of the physical education department.
